This visionary plan will identify how enhancements to the current bus system, new high capacity transit services and emerging transportation technologies can improve future mobility and accessibility for our residents and visitors.

THE NEED

The Southern Nevada region is rapidly growing and growth is happening everywhere – from new sports teams to new hospitals; from new master planned communities to new employment centers; from new resorts to new education facilities.

As a community, we need to identify enhanced multi-modal options that will support this growth, reinvest in our neighborhoods, and allow us to move large amounts of people reliably and efficiently - On Board will help identify potential solutions to this challenge.

THE BENEFITS

ON BOARD WILL:

- Identify where enhancements to the current transit system, such as new, more frequent and faster routes, would provide the most benefit to riders and the surrounding community.
- 2. Identify first-and-last mile connections to major transit hubs, including rideshare, bikeshare, pedestrian improvements, and other mobility options.
- 3. Identify the corridors where high capacity transit services such as bus rapid transit, streetcar, or light rail would provide the most benefit to riders and the regional economy.
- 4. Identify emerging transportation technologies that could enhance mobility for all modes of travel.

THE PROCESS


